#### WORD OF GOD SUNDAY

Last weekend we celebrated, at the request of Pope Francis, **Word of God Sunday** and suggested a few things for you to look out for and to be alert to, using a few questions. So today, we give you some information to make sense of those questions:

Something was different—could you name just what is different? We don't usually process the Lectionary in the gathering procession, and the book looked to be a different book.

Why was the book different to the one we usually use?

The book used on Word of God Sunday was the **Book of the Gospels**. Where the Lectionary does indeed include the weekly gospel readings, the book of the Gospels does not include the first and second readings. The Book of the Gospels of a symbol of our access to God, through Jesus the Christ, and made possible by the power of the Holy Spirit. It only contains the gospel readings and is carried in procession as an "icon" of Christ himself. The word 'gospel' means 'good news' and the good news is not something but *someone*. Jesus Christ is indeed good news. His words call us to listen, to hear, to take to heart the message, in order that we can be transformed by his very presence as the proclamation of his words, as good news, to a people who long for truth, goodness, and beauty.

And why place it open at the end of the Gospel reading?

Liturgical traditions of East and West have given special reverence to the books containing the words of Christ over books containing other sacred scriptures. By placing the Book of the Gospels in its own place, in a sense we 'enshrine' it - because the proclamation of God's very word, housed in the Book of the Gospels, should indeed be awesome. It should stir our being to pay attention, to contemplate the depth of meaning, and to live the Word of Christ in our daily life. We reverence the Book of the Gospels because Christ is present in the proclamation of his words, calling us to live these words in our life.

A return to carrying only a book of the Gospels during the entrance process is actually a return to a more ancient Christian liturgical practice to help us focus on the person of Christ, our Risen Saviour.
