The church celebrates the Feast of St John Vianney – patron saint of parish priests - on Monday 4th August. On the back of this, the invitation has been put forward by local parishes and prayer groups to pray for the priests in our Geelong deanery. Not to garner your pity, but the truth is that much is expected of our Parish Priests, who can often find themselves feeling isolated or overwhelmed. There are a number of studies conducted in the area, but overall the morale and wellbeing of priests is not in a great place. Despite what many might think, it's not because of the bad press and public pressure on the church from without, but from people and structures within. Priests report feeling burned out, frustrated with the diocese leadership and not feeling supported in their work, which for younger priests is compounded by the generational gap between the younger and older clergy.

Rest assured it's not all doom and gloom! The vast majority of priests still report being happy in their vocation and if they had their time over, they would do it again. This priest included, praise God!

So here is a little opportunity to call on St John Vianney as their patron and pray for Parish Priests everywhere, that they may discharge their duties and serve their people with faithfulness and joy.

Saint John Vianney, you were blessed with a loving and devout family who supported your desire to increase your faith and devote yourself fully towards imitating the life of our Lord Jesus Christ.
