POPE'S MONTHLY INTENTIONS For mutual coexistence

Let us pray that societies where coexistence seems more difficult might not succumb to the temptation of confrontation for ethnic, political, religious, or ideological reasons.



Dear parishioners,

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is one of the great solemnities of the church's year. It is honoured on the 15th of August, and testifies to the truth that "the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory" (Catechism of the Catholic Church 966).

The doctrine was defined by the church in the year 1950 by Pope Pius XII. It highlights both the unique role of Mary in our salvation and reminds us that a share in Christ's resurrection is possible for all souls that model and reflect her faithfulness and love.

It was fitting that on Friday's solemnity the parish welcomed and blessed a beautiful icon of Our Lady at St Therese' Church. It as written and donated generously to the parish by Mr Geoffrey Horgan, who often stays at Anglesea. (Geoff also produced the crucifix hanging in the prayer chapel behind the sanctuary of St Therese). Geoff painted using natural pigments in egg tempera, which is known for its durability and its ability to produce rich and vibrant colours. He has done a wonderful job.

The icon is a copy of a famous Russian icon titled "Our Lady of the Don", painted by Theophanes of Novgorod in the late 14th Century. It's named such because for most of its life the image lived in the Donskoy Monastery in Moscow.

Like all icons, the image has certain features that convey theological truths. The touching of the faces of the mother and child show the special tenderness of the Blessed Mother with the Divine Infant. But even more importantly, it reveals to us the love the God has for his creation. That He loves us so much as to give to us his only begotten Son.


The icon originally had a golden background, which symbolises the divine nature and the eternal light of heaven. Interestingly, the original icon is double-sided, with a depiction of the Assumption of Mary on the other side. Rather fitting. The icon currently hangs in the Tretyakov Gallery in Moscow.

I hope that this gift to our church will help foster an ever greater devotion to Mary our Mother, who is so tender and loving and so near to us in time of need. I lose count at how often I'm told of the blessings and benefits that are granted to those who pray to her.
