Dear Parishioners,

It's been a little while since I've written for the bulletin. In the meantime, quite a bit has been happening around the parish. The most significant of those things was our parish Confirmations. Bishop Martin Ashe was here on two separate evenings over two weeks to confirm over 150 candidates. Praise God. Thanks to those who helped prepare the students through our parish program and to the choir who went over and above by providing music for these special events. And a big thanks to our secretary Tracy, patiently dealing with all the admin and correspondence of all of it! Recent weeks has also seen the occasion of my ten-year anniversary of ordination to the priesthood. Thank you for all the prayers and well wishes and the lovely cards and gifts. It is all very much appreciated. My parents Peter and Rosemary were able to attend the 9am mass and they were very moved by the gratitude and warmth shown them. The bouquet of flowers for mum at the end of mass was a lovely touch! God bless all of you.

The greatest and most powerful things I do as a priest is minister the sacraments, as they make present in a special way the person of Jesus Christ. It was fitting that following my anniversary was a week that I ministered or celebrated each of the seven sacraments of the church. It was a first for me and good chance it'll be the last time that happens. The regular sacraments for a priest are celebrating the Eucharist and hearing confessions, which I did. In this parish, baptising and anointing the sick are also regular and I offered those too. A little more out-of-the-blue I confirmed Guryel Ali, a Catechumen, into the Catholic faith at St Therese on Sunday the 14<sup>th</sup> of September. On the last day of that week, I concelebrated at the mass bestowing Holy Orders upon three young men at St Patrick's Cathedral and lastly, on that same day, I presided at a Catholic Rite of Holy Matrimony at St Mary's in West Melbourne. It was pretty cool.

In reflecting on this, I couldn't help but think what a blessing my vocation has been and the privilege that it offers. In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus promises to give back 100-fold to those that leave property and family for his sake. From what I can tell, he's making good on his promise.
