Week Two

The Synodal Journey

Pope Leo emphasized the importance of being "a missionary Church, a Church that builds bridges and encourages dialogue, a Church ever open to welcoming, like St Peter's Square, with it's open arms, all those who are in need of our charity, our presence our readiness to dialogue and our love."

A synodal Church should not be excluding of individuals on account of their marital situation, identity or sexuality.

"What emerged throughout the entire synodal journey ...was the call for a Church with a greater capacity to nurture relationships. Many participants were delighted to be asked to share their thoughts and to be given the opportunity to have their voices heard in the community... to express the pain of feeling excluded or judged because of their marital status, identity or sexuality." (Final Document, par. 50)

"Inequality between men and women is not part of God's design." (FD par. 52)

After Mass this weekend, please engage in a meaningful conversation with someone about what you have read and reflected upon above.



Mary Glowrey Museum Open Day Wednesday 29 October 2025 | 10.00am-3.00pm

The Mary Glowrey Museum in Fitzroy documents the life and legacy of Dr Sr Mary Glowrey JMJ (1887-1957), Australian-born and educated medical missionary. In 1920, Mary Glowrey left her medical career in Melbourne to serve in India, where she became Sr Mary of the Sacred Heart JMJ and devoted 37 years to caring for the most marginalised. Declared a Servant of God in 2013, she is one of only two Australians officially being considered for canonisation. Find out more at: www.maryglowreymuseum.info



The State Government is seeking to amend Victoria's euthanasia and assisted suicide laws. If passed, the new laws would further weaken protections for vulnerable patients and reduce protections for nurses, doctors and other medical practitioners who conscientiously object. In response, the Bishops of Victoria have written a pastoral letter asking that we contact our local Members of Parliament and urge them to vote against these laws.
