Dear Parishioners,

It was an inspiration from our secretary, Tracy, that got this parish initiative off the ground. With children of her own in our parish schools, she noticed that at the end of the year awards are given for many categories—art, sport, various academic disciplines and more. So why not one from the parish for a student who makes a real effort in the area of faith and religion? I thought it was a great idea, and so the Nazareth Catholic Parish award for "Excellence in Virtue" was born. It recognises a student "for outstanding efforts in religious education, devotion to faith, and living out the love of Jesus in our community."

I'm glad to say it was readily embraced by each of our four parish primary schools. Guided by our criteria, the principals were confident in nominating worthy winners, we look forward to announcing the winner next week once they have been presented at the end of year school assemblies over the coming week.

It is a slightly strange thing to give an award that puts a spotlight on someone's virtue when the foundational virtue on which all others are built is humility. We could well be filling these kids with spiritual pride and setting them on the road to perdition! Jokes aside, I do think this will be encouraging for both the individuals and the whole student body. Children see what is valued and praised, and they respond positively. It's really not that complicated.

I think here of the writings of St Gregory Nazianzen, reflecting on his friendship with St Basil the Great. He writes of their joint pursuit of wisdom: "This is an ambition especially subject to envy. Yet between us there was no envy. On the contrary, we made capital out of our rivalry. Our rivalry consisted, not in seeking the first place for oneself but in yielding it to the other, for we each looked on the other's success as his own."

That is what true charity is: willing the good of another, spurring them on, and celebrating their achievements as a win for the whole community. As simple as it is, it sends a message to our students and families that living out the faith in this parish is not just words in a brochure, but something we take seriously and recognise.
